

## Four Day Workshop on **Project Management** April 18-21, 2017 – Mirpurkhas, Sindh

### **TRAINING OVERVIEW**

Small organizations often struggle to access and implement project management tools and processes in their organizational system. Completing projects within the set timeframe and budget is already a challenge and the time and resources required to undertake project

management training are usually outside the existing capacities of these small organizations. However, strong project management is vital to the successful implementation of a good quality project, as well as to the prospects of the organization for obtaining funding and continuing in their interventions in the future.

The 4-day project management training will cater to the specific project management needs of smaller NGO's to enable them to plan, organize, implement, and evaluate their project. Over the course of these four days, workshop participants will build a solid foundation of project management tools spanning the entire project cycle.

### TARGET AUDIENCE

This 4-day training session is suitable for CSO and NGO workers of all levels, particularly from locally-based organizations with a small staff size.

### METHODOLOGIES

- Participatory workshop is adopted for the training. Participants will be asked to share personal experiences and their level of awareness regarding the topic.
- Lectures, role plays, group work, audio visual aids and presentations will be used for making the concept of project management clearer.
- Handouts and leaflets will be distributed and discussed.

### LANGUAGE

Proficiency in Urdu is required with a minimum understanding of English to understand some technical terminologies; however, the medium of instruction will be Urdu.
