This training provides you with a practical introduction to project planning, it's conceptual understanding and real-world applications. It showcases how effective implementation planning adds value to your project outcomes and make them sustainable. You will develop, refine and sharpen your own project plans as per the requirements of specific donors and your organization.

Training Methodology

A participant-oriented approach is adopted in this training involving activity-based learning, facilitated self-learning, discussions and group work. Your own individual projects are on the foreground and each participant will be able to design implementation plans of their own projects.

Participants

This training is designed for mid-level managers with interest and prior experience in project planning and execution in development sector organizations. The participants are expected to have basic knowledge of project planning and management.

Learning Outcomes

Project Planning training is aimed at strengthening conceptual clarity on project planning tools and approaches including result-based PCM. Furthermore, the training will help project planners and implementers to practice innovative tools for project implementation planning and enhance their skills for effective and efficient utilization of time and resources.

This training will enable participants to:

- Design Performance Management Framework in relation to project LFA
 Plan and conduct Result-based monitoring and reporting
- Develop Work Breakdown Structure (WBS), Work Plan, Budget and Risk Register
- Plan and conduct Result-based monitoring and reporting
- Conduct gender sensitive planning and execution of projects
