What is the Quality and Accountability Learning Camp?

The Quality and Accountability Learning Camp (QAL Camp) is an eight-week online programme that aims to promote quality, accountability, and performance improvement-related learning activities that will be offered at the regional level in the Asia-Pacific. It will bring together nominated professionals from around the region who are actively delivering value in their communities, but may further want to familiarise themselves with Q&A standards.

The camp aims to provide updates on the latest developments and tools on themes around Quality and Accountability and will facilitate discussions on contextualization, localisation, and learning for continuous improvement in future initiatives.

Who are we?

Community World Service Asia (CWSA) is a humanitarian and development organisation and a member of Sphere and the Core Humanitarian Standard (CHS) Alliance. We are also the Regional Focal Point for the Asian Disaster Risk Reduction Network's (ADRRN) Quality & Accountability Hub, Sphere Country Focal Point in Pakistan and the Regional Partner in Asia for Sphere. CWSA is highly committed towards Accountability to Affected People and People Centred Aid.

Who is the camp for?

Humanitarian & Development workers who:

- Have a role and basic experience on main streaming and strengthening the Quality and Accountability tools, processes and procedures in their organisation(s)/country
- Are interested in learning and promoting Quality, and Accountability to Affected People
- Reside in an Asia Pacific country and actively work there
- Have a 'good enough' command of English
- Will Commit to attending all sessions

What will you take back?

- How to contextualise quality and accountability to affected people in your organisations and in the context of your country
- Peer learning and experience sharing from different context in the Asia Pacific region
- Reference tools that you can use in the future to improve quality and accountability in your own organisation
- Networking with peers

What are you paying?

- Selected participants should be willing to pay USD 200 for the complete course
- Partial scholarship may be applied for organisations with limited funding, women participants and organisations working with marginalised groups
